Jared Buell, 113-115 Boston Street, Italian Villa, c1850.

New owners (2007) recently converted this house from a double to a single residence, leaving in place features often used by New Haven architect Henry Austin. The symmetrical outline, tall front windows, eared door frames, and broad eaves on both house and porch are typical of his style. A small, barely noticeable cupola has been added. In 1819 Jared Buell married Lydia Marie Weld, who was the fifteenth of the eighteen children born to her parents, Edmund and Charlotte Stone Weld.
