bridge, the State drastically widened the road and clipped the edges of the property, injuring its intimacy and tiny scale. In self-defense the owners have planted evergreens, and soon the place will be invisible. Formerly the house was light in color, and its lines showed up in relation to the levels and wall around it. It was one of the pleasures of driving into Guilford from the east.

The house itself remains a typical example of the one-anda-half story house of the Federal period, ornamented only by its door with two transom lights. For more information about this riverside neighborhood, see 32 Boston Post Road.
