Gothic cottages with their frills and whimsy were rare birds in sober Guilford. Here is a very cautious version of the style—the front gable of modest pitch, brackets and porch restrained. In actual fact the owner seems not to have been able to make up his mind whether he wanted the Gothic style at all or would rather stick to the more familiar Italianate or even the ever-safe Colonial. Originally his ornament would have been less retiring than now, for it would presumably have been painted in a slightly deeper shade than the wall, which would probably have been a soft fawn or grey.
