Diminutive in size, the facade almost wholly given over to the windows which seem by contrast large and stately, this little house today has great appeal in spite of changes. The bracketed porch with its crisp wooden railing enhances the effect of lightness and daintiness.

Immediately after it was built, the house was conveyed from Edwin Griswold to Samuel Griswold (cost, \$1100). The present owners recently found in the attic Samuel's honorable discharge from the Union Army in the Civil War.
