

The date of c1847 suggests that this house probably began life as an Italian Villa with a flat roof. Then, as frequently happened, was enlarged with a mansard and dormers, probably c1870. Now covered with aluminum/vinyl siding, it shows little original trim, which makes its history hard to explore. The slate roof is exceptional in Guilford and very handsome. Until well into the 20th century a blacksmith shop was operated in the rear.
