## 8. NOTABLE FEATURES

Wide overhanging eaves; frieze; brackets along the eaves; arched stairway window; doorway with an entablature and fluted pilasters.

## 9. ARCHITECTURAL-HISTORICAL

The removal of the front porch has altered the original appearance of this house. The brackets under the eaves remain from the time of construction. This house in the style of the Italian Villa is an important residential element in an area threatened by increased commercial development.

Hart Landon, a veteran of the Civil War, was a prominent citizen. One of the speakers at the dedication of the Civil War monument on the Green, a Master of St. Alban's Lodge, and State Representative in 1893.
