8. NOTABLE FEATURES

Wide eaves; frieze; square columns on large square bases support the porch; sidelights flank the door; large granite block foundation.

9. ARCHITECTURAL-HISTORICAL

This small Italian villa on Church Street is smaller in scale than some of the others in the village. It is similar to, but less elaborate than, the two villas at #11 and #15 Fair Street. The Church Street house has a portico with square columns on square bases.

The builder was apparently Fred Fowler; the 1852 map indicates the house belonged to Fowler and Pillsbury.
