7. ALTERATIONS

Side and rear additions. Doorway appears to be modern.

8. NOTABLE FEATURES

Twelve over twelve sash, six over six sash in gable; stone slab foundation.

9. ARCHITECTURAL-HISTORICAL

This small house was built a decade or so before the many Greek Revival houses were built in this area. It is a simple story and a half house that may have had another type of doorway at one time.

Henry Dudley (1799-1862)oldest son of Amos, Jr. married Vesta Bradley in 1823 and built this house just west of the river and north of the road in 1828-9.
