## 7. ALTERATIONS

Concrete foundation; bubble skylight on the first story portion.

## 8. NOTABLE FEATURES

Wide overhanging eaves; wide frieze; cupola with a finial; 6/6 sash; portico with fluted columns with stylized capitals and bases.

## 9. ARCHITECTURAL-HISTORICAL

This house was originally built on the north side of the green just east of the Congregational Church. It was built by William Weld as the parsonage to the Church. Although this house is an Italian villa, it has the same strong features and ample proportions used by Weld when working in other styles. The cupola, however, seems somewhat underscaled.

According to his ledger, William Weld built the parsonage during the period July-December 1856 for the sum of \$2155.10. The parsonage served the Church until it was moved in 1964.
