7. ALTERATIONS

Siding; window sash; concrete faced foundation.

8. NOTABLE FEATURES

Boxed cornice (pedimented); square gable window; doorway with pilasters and an entablature.

9. ARCHITECTURAL-HISTORICAL

This Greek Revival resembles many others of the period both in the village and in the outlying areas. The gable window while rectangular in shape is larger and squarer than most others. The doorway has a substantial entablature and well proportioned pilasters.

This house has been difficult to date, a title search has been inconclusive. Henry B. Davis is recorded as owner of the land in 1844, however no house appears on the 1852 map. A house appears here on the 1868 map with name $H.\underline{V}$. Davis, middle initial an error as property appears in probate records of 1893 as belonging to Henry B. Davis.
