5051 Durham Rd

A mile to the north is the town line of Durham. Surrounding the property are nineteenth and twentieth century single-family dwellings.

Other notable features of building or site

The porch roof is supported by slender, decorative posts. Fenestration consists of four-over-four doublehung sash windows. A brick chimney runs up the north elevation of the house. Additions are attached on the west and south elevations of the house.

Historical or Architectural importance

George Franklin Seifert was born in 1892 and married Nellie Thedy. In the 1930 United States Federal Census of Guilford, Connecticut, Seifert is listed as age 39 living on Middletown Turnpike. His occupation was sawyer in a Lumber Mill and he was living with his wife, Nellie, and seven children. In the 1940 Federal Census records George Seifert was listed as a farmer living on Guilford Street.
