Boxed pedimented cornice; frieze; 6/6 sash; wide lintel boards; entry with fluted columns; plain pilasters, entablature hood; and sidelights flank the door; grey granite foundation.

9. ARCHITECTURAL-HISTORICAL

This strong Greek Revival house was built by William Weld for Captain John Seward. The substantial entablature and columns make this one of the bolder Greek Revival doorways in Guilford.

Captain Seward built his house near the East River Wharf, which was once busy with shipping long before the railroad trestle was built.
