## 9. ARCHITECTURAL-HISTORICAL

This house was built by Jared Dudley, great grandson of William Dudley, one of Guilford's founders, a Covenanter. Jared Dudley, a captain in the militia, married Mary Chittenden and brought her over the threshold of this half-house Christmas Eve 1754. For some unknown reason, the house was never expanded, according to common practice. The Dudley family sold the house in 1964.
