8. NOTABLE FEATURES

Overhanging eaves with rafters visible; decorative bargeboards with pendants; moulding around window; decorative porch with brackets.

9. ARCHITECTURAL-HISTORICAL

This house with ample overhanging eaves and elements of stick style decoration dates from the late 1860's. The house has bargeboards and a pendant in the front gable and a porch with braces at each post.

The house is on the 1868 Map with the name J. Coan beside it. Jerome Coan was the son of John Coan, one of three brothers who emigrated from England. Jerome served in the Civil War. After the war he opened a country store in North Guilford. Active in the North Congregational Church, he died 9 Nov. 1899 in this house just across the street from the house in which he was born.
