Large dormer on rear roof, also leanto roof line raised; shed addition in rear; slate "fish scale" roof (1890s); chimney rebuilt; pediment doorway.

- 8/12 sash in second story and 12/12 sash in the first 8. NOTABLE FEATURES story; a band of cut away circles decorating the cornice; protruding window frames in the front portion of the house; water shed covering the sill.
- Even though the roof line of this house has been 9. ARCHITECTURAL-HISTORICAL altered, the building retains its historic character and has features not commonly found in other 18th century houses in Guilford such as the projecting window frames and the "water shed" board above the foundation. House built by the Fourth Church and Society of Guilford as a parsonage for the Rev. Daniel Brewer. Brewer lived there for several years but was then dismissed. He had embraced the beliefs of the Sandemanians and this was unacceptable to his congregation.
