Jerkinhead roof shape; board and batten siding; double grouped windows; overhanging eaves with brackets; porch original; door with sidelights.

9. ARCHITECTURAL-HISTORICAL

A fine example of Gothic Revival architecture; a style not well represented in Guilford. This house is one of two Gothic houses on Fair Street, and part of an outstanding grouping of 18th and 19th century houses.

James Monroe built a number of houses in town including this one and 63 Fair Street. Monroe was active in getting town to support the government's side in the Civil War.
