Boxed cornice; frieze; rectangular gable window (with decorative muntins); 6/6 sash; doorway with an entablature and pilasters.

The Greek Revival style survived for many years 9. ARCHITECTURAL-HISTORICAL in Guilford and this is an excellent late example. Although this house has the door way with entablature and pilasters and the decorative rectangular gable window that represent the style, the lack of returns on the cornice shows the later development of the style. Separated from the road by an expanse of planted grounds and lawns, this house is an important part of its rural environment.

This property is identified on the 1868 Map as owned by Jas. D. Goldsmith. Goldsmith, a Democrat, was a Selectman in 1896. He was a director of the Guilford Agricultural Society in 1879.
