Shingle siding; rear addition; large windows on the south side; addition on the south side.

8. NOTABLE FEATURES

Boxed cornice with returns; 6/6 sash; moulding around original gable window; square-columned portico (a later addition).

9. ARCHITECTURAL-HISTORICAL

It would appear that the house was built and owned by the Bartlett family for many years. (The 1852 map identifies its owners as Nathaniel; the 1863 map, as C.O. Bartlett). The Bartletts continue to have large land ownings in the North Guilford area; cf. 564 Great Hill Road.

This house is a variation of the Greek Revival form; the long returns are similar to those at 134 Great Hill Road.
