The trim along the eaves of this house and its placement with a gable end toward the street are important characteristics of this building. This is a good example of a North Guilford farm which has a fine row of barns with stone foundations just across the road. This house plays an important role in preserving the rural character of Great Hill Road.

The original owner, W. Daniel, remains obscure. The property has belonged to the Bartletts at least since 1852 (cf. map).
