The jerkinhead roof appears on several houses in Guilford. This nicely proportioned house is in keeping with the scale of its neighborhood. Although the porch has been enclosed, changing the overall look of the facade, the leaded glass window has been retained as a reminder of the original appearance of the house.

A title search has proven inconclusive on this house, appearance points to a date in the early 20th century.
