8. NOTABLE FEATURES

Overhanging eaves with a moulding below; 12/12 sash; 6/6 in the garret and the second floor roof eaves; very thin mouldings above the window frames; thin window sills; doorway with a five pane transom; plain doo frame, and a crown moulding above the transom.

9. ARCHITECTURAL-HISTORICAL

This house has a facade with two windows on each side of a central doorway and gable ends with a large center window and smaller ones on either side and in the garret. There are typical features of Guilford many story-and-a-half Colonial houses. Here the facade is highlighted by a door surmounted with mouldings and a transom in the frame. house is a very fine example of its form and style.
