7. ALTERATIONS

Two story side bay; brick chimney; Greek Revival doorway with pilasters and entablature.

8. NOTABLE FEATURES

Boxed cornice, with a moulding below; frieze; 12/12 sash; two 6/6 sash in the gable.

9. ARCHITECTURAL-HISTORICAL

This house has a well-balanced nine-window facade, enhanced by its small-paned windows, important features. Later changes, such as the Greek Revival doorway and the 19th century two-story bay are discreet additions.

According to Steiner, Guilford's historian, John Morse was the only resident on Leete's Island before the Revolution who was not a member of the Leete family. Morse inherited some of the property from his father, Seth, but John was the original owner of the house.
