Side additions; rear addition; rear roof line altered; chimney rebuilt.

8. NOTABLE FEATURES

Boxed cornice with returns (on the sides); 6/6 sash; doorway with pilasters, and an entablature; rectangular windows in the gable.

9. ARCHITECTURAL-HISTORICAL

The broad space above the doors and windows of the facade give evidence of the upper story of this story-and-a-half house. The space also sets off the row of shuttered windows and the entablatured and pilastered doorway. Additions have not impaired the scale of this house, a fine example of its type in a rural setting.

The history of its original owner, Kelsey, remains obscure.
