6/6 sash; window openings enlarged; chimney rebuilt - brick.

8. NOTABLE FEATURES

Wide corner boards; plan door frame; large stone block foundation; gambrel roof.

9. ARCHITECTURAL-HISTORICAL

A small three bay, one and a half story house with a gambrel roof, and one of the few of this size and style. The large dominating center chimney has been rebuilt using brick. The windows, which seem out of scale, may have been enlarged.

George Dudley, the name assigned to the house, may have been the man, born in 1721, who married Martha Coan 18 January 1759. They settled in Stockbridge, Massachusetts (date not recorded).
