## 8. NOTABLE FEATURES

Narrow frieze; 6/6 sash; doorway with slender pilasters and an entablature; stone foundation and chimney.

## 9. ARCHITECTURAL-HISTORICAL

This fine five-bay story-and-a-half house has features which place it in the Federal, or possibly early Greek Revival Period. A plaque on the house gives the name of Crampton and a date of 1757. The pitch of the roof, the cornices with small returns, and the narrow frieze make it difficult to date as early as 1757. house would appear to date from the first quarter of the 19th century or slightly thereafter. Further investigation might reveal an earlier structure on the site. This house is located in a wooded area at the eastern side of the township near the present Madison town line.

The house appears on the 1852 Map with the name Daniel Foster.
