9. ARCHITECTURAL-HISTORICAL

The information on this house is confusing and will require further investigation. Judging from the off-center chimney and the uneven window spacing, the house has been altered at one time or another. It is difficult to tell from the exterior which side is the original. The story and a half house appears in both the Colonial and the Federal periods, however, there is no detail work on this house to tie it definitely to one period or the other. The dates 1780 and 1830 have both been given for this house.

The name Lewis Evarts has been given as one owner of this house in 1830. As there were many members of the Evarts family living in the Nut Plains area more study will be necessary to connect the various family members to the houses in that locality.
