This house, with a nine-window facade, was one room deep in 1740. A break in the roof line indicates that the lean-to was probably a later addition. A covering of composition shingles does not disguise the house's attractive form. It is a good representative of Guilford's Colonial houses.

Joseph Hall built this house while his brother, John, built an identical house, just to the south, on the very same day. (John's house collapsed about 1940). This house has been held by the Hall family to date (1969).
