The alternating fish scale and straight shingles, probably a later addition along with the porch, have become the outstanding features on the one and a half story house. One of a row of houses of similar scale. Developed between 1852 and 1868.

Cornelius Shea, its owner, died in 1887, leaving his wife Catherine executrix of his estate.
