Siding; outside chimney; second floor porch in the rear.

8. NOTABLE FEATURES

Boxed cornice with returns; square gable window; square column porch with a row of dentils along eaves; brick foundation.

9. ARCHITECTURAL-HISTORICAL

Although larger than many of its kin, this Greek Revival house has the three-bay facade typical of Guilford buildings of this style. It is an important member of the large group of Greek Revival style houses outside of the Village of Guilford and helps maintain the residential scale of the street.

This house is thought to be one of the later works of William Weld.
