Alternating hip and gable roof dormers; decorative diamond pane window overhanging second story form the roof of the porch (supported by square posts).

9. ARCHITECTURAL-HISTORICAL

The overhanging gambred-roofed second story makes a pleasant open porch for this seaside house as well as offering cool shade for the rooms behind it. Dormers with different roof styles add a playful note to the broad roof of this house. It is a good representative of the cottages built along the Sound in the early years of this century. Frank E. Hayden tore down two earlier cottages on this site and had this single large cottage built on the site.
