9. ARCHITECTURAL-HISTORICAL

This is an example of the seaside cottages which developed with the vogue for summer sojourns at the beach, at the end of the 19th century.

Dominating this small one story house is a large porch that wraps around two sides. The roof is supported by turned posts and small spindles form the porch railing and the open frieze of the cornice line.
