8. NOTABLE FEATURES

Segmental arched gable window; doorway with pilasters (leaf-like design in the capital area) and a stylized entablature with a leaf-like design in the frieze; stone foundation.

9. ARCHITECTURAL-HISTORICAL

The Italianate taste of the 1870s imposed itself on Guilford with discretion. In the George Bradley house, the Greek Revival form is still evident, although details like the segmental arch of the gable window, the tall narrow windows, and the leafy decoration around the door point to newer trends. This house fits in well on a street of houses of similar scale.
