8. NOTABLE FEATURES

Front porch with spindles, turned posts, and widely flared brackets. Now painted white, these stand out vividly against the shadowy porch behind. Side bay. Fine group of barns at rear.

9. ARCHITECTURAL-HISTORICAL

Set in a wide lawn, with its barns still standing out back, this comfortable house reminds us that farming, even in the village, continued to be a way of life in Guilford down through the 19th century and beyond.

Although this house has had synthetic siding applied to it, it closely resembles several houses in the first block of Church Street(#96). Long cornice returns may have been on the State Street house. This area of town does not appear on the Birdseye map.
