Set in a wooded area well out from the village center, this house has boards with scroll-cut tracery, decorative rafters and brackets supporting overhanging eaves, and ornamental siding in the gables. All these features are part of the late Victorian architectural fashion known as the Stick Style. It is relatively rare in Guilford, and the few houses that went in for its surface richness gain value by their scarcity. This house is an elegant and well-preserved example.

This area does not appear on the maps available for its time period. This house like 91 State was also Benton property and large land holdings have made the title search inconclusive.
