Siding; window sash; front fenestration altered; brick chimney; side and rear additions.

8. NOTABLE FEATURES
Overhang of the third story; doorway with a five pane transom; moulding around the door frame, and a crown moulding above the transom.

9. ARCHITECTURAL-HISTORICAL

Part of a farm with several old barns and fields that slope down to the saltmarshes, this house is itself a wonderful puzzle. The doorway is not in line with the chimney, which sits forward of the roof ridge, and extra windows have been inserted in the second floor. Composition shingles make it even harder to discern its original form. Even if the house is an enigma, this farm makes an important contribution to the neighborhood and is an excellent reminder of Guilford's rural heritage.

In 1729 Samuel Stone and three other men surveyed and measured the Guilford Green.
