Double front door; pediment door hood (recessed panel pilasters); transom.

9. ARCHITECTURAL-HISTORICAL

A door hood shelters the entrance of this house which has the fine broad proportions of the Federal Period. The transom of small rectangular panes is similar to the gable windows of many of Guilford's Greek Revival Houses. Although an 18th century date has been given to this house by some, the appearance of the house supports an early 19th century date.

A title search on this house proved inconclusive.
