Boxed cornice; overhanging eaves; frieze; shingles on the second story and clapboards on the first story with a moulding separating the sidings. 6/6 sash; hipped roof dormer; rectangular bay on the porch.

9. ARCHITECTURAL-HISTORICAL

This two story house is a good example of the American Foursquare which became popular in the early 20th Century. Characteristic of of the style are the square shape and hipped roof. The dormer and porch on this house also have hipped roofs. A separation between the stories occurs through the use of two types of siding; shingles on the second story and clapboards on the first story.
