- 8 NOTABLE FEATURES Five window facade; asymmetrical door placement; overhang ing eaves; T-shape chimney; 8/12 sash; protruding window frames; stone foundation and a wide board covering the sill.
- The Joseph Clay or Acadian house is so important as evidence of 17th century building techniques 9. ARCHITECTURAL-HISTORICAL that architectural histories regularly refer to it. The five windows of its facade are irregularly spaced. The addition of the lean-to to this two room deep house is marked by a change in roof slope. A T-shaped chimney crowns the house. It is an outstanding example of Guilford's early architecture.

Joseph Clay and his bride came to Guilford from Saybrook in 1670. Their daughter, Sarah, wife of John Chittenden, inherited the house which remained in this family for 144 years. Following the destruction of Grand Pre, the British put ashore 16 Acadian refugees (from Nova Scotia) in the fall of 1755. They were given shelter in this house until "put out to service."

This house is on the National Register.
