Boxed cornice with a moulding below the eaves; simple moulding around the door frame; stone chimney.

9. ARCHITECTURAL-HISTORICAL

The Darius Collins house, nearly a hundred years later than its neighbor at 37 Union Street, also has an off-center five-window facade. The roof-line runs smoothly, perhaps indicating a lean-to that was integral to this one-room plus lean-to house from its orgins. A simple moulding frames the doorway of this Colonial house.
