## 8. NOTABLE FEATURES

Decorative shingles in gable and on porch gable; curvilinear bargeboards in gable peak; stained glass stair window; turned porch posts with brackets.

## 9. ARCHITECTURAL-HISTORICAL

The use of shingles in the gable simplified window hoods and curvilinear bargeboards in the peak of the gable dress up this modest two story house. A shed roof porch extends along the front of this narrow three bay house with a gable placed over the entrance. Decorative shingles are placed in the porch gable and the roof is supported by turned posts with brackets.
