Notable Features

There two small fixed windows over each door. In the center, under the sign "Auger's Irish Pub" is a large bay window with five panes. A large wood deck with stairs lead up to the entry. In its place used to be, as of 1981, a two story porch, with the second level being only in the center and enclosed. The second level large windows were probably once doors leading out to the porch.
