Rear addition; new clapboards on front facade 1982; shingles on side.

8. NOTABLE FEATURES

Front door in the center of the facade; doorway with an entablature (with a slight curve in the frieze), and plain pilasters.

9. ARCHITECTURAL-HISTORICAL

The windows in the second floor gable end of this small house are larger than they could have been if its builder had followed tradition in lining them up over the first-floor windows. The slight bend of the doorway entablature shows a Greek Revival form already under the influence of a later Victorian style. In a setting where the ruins of a concrete trolley overpass loom large, this small house with its graden, hedge, and picket gate are picturesque.
