The recessed doorway with both sidelights and transom gives the street face of this Grecian Villa an interesting boost. The clover-leaf decorative openings of the roof monitor may be a local builder's hallmark; for a similar one, see the Isbell house, 100 Water Street. A bracketed two-story bay at the side adds a Victorian ornament to the more severe geometry of the original house—a good example of the sturdy form of the Villa style.
