Siding; aluminum windows; railing on the front.

8. NOTABLE FEATURES eaves with rafters; decorative bargeboards; brackets under the eaves (at the corners of the house); beveled sides on the side "wing" (with pendants); porch with decorative posts, spindles, bargeboards, and shingles.

## 9. ARCHITECTURAL-HISTORICAL

Like many smaller houses of the Queen Anne style, this one shows a simple form with few decorative touches, e.g., the bargeboards and spindle-railed porch. Composition siding probably hides clapboard and decoratively cut shingles. This is a fine example of the modest homes of the last decades of the 19th century, in a style not common in Guilford.
