8. NOTABLE FEATURES

Facade is three bays wide; some smaller 6/6 sash in gable and lean-to portions; stone chimney; stone foundation.

9. ARCHITECTURAL-HISTORICAL

This center-chimney salt box is a very good example of the town's colonial architecture. Three bays wide and one-room deep, plus lean-to, it is typical of moderate-sized houses of the period. At present, it is in a state of virtual abandonment and disrepair with broken windows and a burned and rotting roof.
