ARCHITECTURAL-HISTORICAL The polygonal tower of this Queen Anne style commercial block dominates the south-west corner of the Green. Modern siding covers the diverse textures of the original surface.

J. Harrison Monroe, a prominent Guilford Democrat, built the 9. ARCHITECTURAL-HISTORICAL

"Monroe block" in 1898 to house his drug store, which he had moved from Water Street. He had bought the old hotel at the corner of Whitfield-Water Streets and part of it was incorporated in the west-wing of this building. Monroe's drug store was on the ground floor • Hotel Halleck occupied the upper floors. Markham's jewelry store rented space here until 1902. The U.S. Post Office rented part of the ground floor from 1903 until the present building was opened.

Monroe's son, Bradford, took over the business. He sold the

building in 1970.
