8. NOTABLE FEATURES

Overhanging eaves with a moulding; 6/6 sash in the gable; twelve over twelve windows on the west side; sidelights flank the west door; stone foundation

9. ARCHITECTURAL-HISTORICAL BENTON

Built by Daniel Bishop in 1827 the property was sold to Bildad Bishop, a merchant, in 1828. This two story structure has adjacent residential and commercial sections and was Bildad Bishop's home and shop until his death in 1880. Bildad Bishop was originally from Madison and licensed to sell wines and liquors in 1840.

The west side, possibly the residential section of the building, a simpler version of a Palladian window, and has sidelights flanking the doorway. The east side, possibly the shop section of the house, is two bays wide with a simpler entryway. Both entryways are Greek Revival and are probably of a later date.
